



Duncan Morrison, BSF, MSc (Brit Col.) PhD (Cantab) was employed as a Forest Pathologist by the Canadian Forest Service, Pacific Forestry Centre, Victoria from 1966-2005 to conduct research on the distribution, epidemiology and management of root diseases of forest trees.
