

## **Harold Macy Wood Lot**

**Start time:** Friday May 13<sup>th</sup> 1:30; return by 5:30 pm

**Meeting Location:** Trailhead at Harold Macy Woodlot is approximately 1 km up the Mt Washington Road west of the Island Highway. There is a yellow gate on the logging road. The coordinates for the trail head are 10U 347356 east, 5510433 north. A Car Pool

map will be available at the Registration desk.

**Car Pool:** Car Pool departs from the Filberg Center at 1:15 pm. Car Pool Map available at Registration Desk.

**Maximum Participants:** 16

**What to Bring:** Binoculars, water and a snack. The walk is shady under the trees and may be cool even on a warm day.

**What to expect on trip:** We have encountered Elk, Bear and Island Deer, but we can always expect 6 to 8 bird species and various species of slugs. The forest is 80 to 100 year old Coastal Western Hemlock Drier Maritime Zone (CWHxm1)

**Difficulty of Trip:** The trip is moderately difficult, mostly on dirt and gravel roads with a 7 to 15 % slope. Unfortunately, this trip is not Wheel Chair Accessible.
