Wander in the 7 acres of grounds and gardens then enjoy a cup of herbal tea in lovely antique china cups and have chance to ask questions and learn about what it takes to run this spectacular plant haven.

From tasting and nibbling on anise hyssop, stevia, and true peppermint in the culinary garden to stroking the furry leaves of mullein in the medicine garden, we will explore the herb gardens, the vegetable beds, the greenhouse, and the orchard.



Along the way, visitors will see the Douglas Senft Memorial Sculpture Park, the largest collection of this famous Canadian artist's work anywhere, the 100' diameter oyster shell labyrinth, the pond, the flower gardens, and the Garry oak planting.

At the end of the visit, the farm shop will be open for purchasing specialty herbal teas, vinegars and more. Visit includes a one-hour garden tour and 30 minutes for tea and questions. Visitors may stay longer if they wish to explore further.

The farm is located at the trailhead of the new Royston Greenway, if visitors would like to explore the surrounding woods as well.
