Loys Maingon is a semi-retired Registered Professional Biologist, prior to working privately he taught environmental studies. He is a limnologist and taxonomist specialized in coastal stream systems ecology and water quality standards. He is currently president of the Comox Valley Naturalists, as well as BC director for the Canadian Society of Environmental Biologists, and was between 2009-2014 Canadian Chair of the CSC/ISO Water Quality Sampling Methods Committee. He has been involved since 1998 as a consulting biologist in environmental and climate change impact assessments, and is familiar with special challenges of Comox Valley's and Vancouver Islands' water management.

The workshop will review problems associated with the Comox Valley's watershed, the limits of current management strategies and policy and legislation, and proposed restoration and management options.
