He is a coral reef biologist and spent considerable time in the tropics. 4 years in Indo China, 3 years in Borneo, concentrating on the South China sea, 3 years in Guyana, and 7 years in the Pacific Islands whilst based in Hawaii where he was curator of the University of Hawaii's Waikiki Aquarium.

In BC, John was the founding Academic Dean, Vice President, then President of North Island College. He continues to take a particular interest in the herring migration in the Salish Sea, which culminates in the Comox Estuary, Baynes Sound and Lambert Channel every year around the second week in March. John was elected a Fellow of the Linnean Society in 1969 and the Zoological Society in 1970.
