Gilled Light-spored

Amanita muscaria	fly agaric
Amanita muscaria white form (OR Amanita smithii)	fly agaric white form OR Smith's amanita
Atheniella aurantiidisca	orange-yellow bonnet
Clitocybe sp.	funnel cap
Craterellus tubaeformis	winter chanterelle
Gymnopus androsaceus	horsehair mushroom
Hygrophoropsis aurantiaca	false chanterelle
Laccaria laccata group	lacklustre laccaria
Lactarius deliciosus group	milky cap
Pleurotus oystoyae group	oyster mushroom
Mycena sp	one of many small brown mycenas!
Mycena epipterygia	yellowleg bonnet
Russula sp	most have reddish caps and chalky white stems
Russula brevipes	a white russula
Tricholoma focale group	veiled orange trich

Gilled bown spored

Cortinarius vanduzerensis group	-viscid orangy-cap, wavy margins, stipe appears white or possibly pale lilac tinge.
Gymnopilus sapineus group	fir flamecap: on mossy conifer logs.

Gilled charcoal/black-spored

Chroogomphus vinicolor OR ochraceus?	pine spike
Coprinopsis stercorea	dung-loving inky cap (on horse dung, see p. 100 Mushrooms of Coastal Redwood forest)
Gomphidius subroseus	rosy gomphidius

Boletes

There are at least 4 or more species of Suillus:

Suillus lakei	Lake's bolete
Suillus tomentosus	-fibrillose scales on a yellowish cap. Pores stain blue, under pines.
Suillus luteus??	-VERY viscid/slimy cap and stipe.
Suillus brevipes	-shiny brown cap, pale yellow pores and white stipe

Fomitopsis mounceae	Red belt polypore
Ganoderma applanatum	Artist's conk
Phaeolus schweinitzii	Dyer's conk
Trichaptum abietinum	
Onnia tomentosa	wooly velvet polypore

Apioperdon pyriforme	pear puffball

Hydnellum auranticaum	orange tooth
Hydnellum peckii	strawberries and cream/blood fungus/jam tart
Phellodon tomentosus	owl eyes
Sarcodon squamosus	scaly tooth/hawk wing (under pines)

Guepiniopsis alpinus	Alpine jelly cone
