Gilled Light-spored

Amanita muscaria	fly agaric
Atheniella aurantiidisca	orange-yellow bonnet
Chrysomphalina aurantiaca	bright orange cap and stem
Lactarius pseudomucidus	grey-stemmed milk cap viscid cap, milky droplets on light coloured gills.
Mycena sp	one of many small brown mycenae!
Mycena epipterygia	yellowleg bonnet
Russula sp	most have reddish caps and chalky white stems
Tricholoma focale group	veiled orange trich -bright coloured cap with orange & green tones thick stem tapers at the base. Adnate gill arrangement.
Tricholoma imbricatum	rich brown coloured cap, can get quite large

Gilled brown spored

Cortinarius sp	brown cap, lighter edge, shades of lilac on gills and stem.
Cortinarius smithii	nut-brown cap, yellow stem and striking deep-red gills
Hebeloma sp	greyish/white cap, slightly inrolled edges, bulbous base, smells like a radish
Inocybe sp	brown, cone-shaped cap with striations.
Lentinellus montanus	beige/brown on wood, short off-center stem, frilly edge.

Gilled dark/black spores

Hygrocybe singeri	western witch's hat (small, bright orange with a cone-shaped cap)
Hypholoma fasciculare	sulfur tuft -usually in clusters on rotten wood, bright yellow beneath with dark spore print.

Boletes

Suillus lakei	Lake's bolete -large pores, fibrous cap
Aureoboletus mirabilis	Admirable Bolete: a wine-coloured suede-textured cap with a thick ochre stem and bright yellow pores beneath
